Job Title: Emergency and Critical Care Clinician

Reports To: Chief Executive Officer

Job Purpose:

- Contribute to excellent patient care for all animals hospitalised in the ICU
- Contribute to the success of the 24-hour emergency referral service
- Contribute to the teaching of undergraduate and postgraduate veterinary students

Principal Accountabilities:

- To accept emergency referral patients and to provide veterinary care as appropriate to those patients including diagnostics, procedures and therapy.
- To provide mentorship and support to PG diploma and PG masters students in their clinical roles.
- To ensure medical record keeping is consistent and that client communication is clear and accurate.
- To provide advice when needed to internal and external veterinary surgeons.
- To work closely with the ICU nursing team to provide excellent inpatient care
- To adhere to Langford Vets procedures and policies
- To contribute to student teaching for veterinary undergraduates on the ICU and emergency medicine rotation and to perform student assessment and feedback.
- To support undergraduate veterinary students as a clinical tutor
- To endeavour to support the growth of Langford Vets through the provision of excellent patient and customer care.
- To endeavour to support the growth of Langford Vets through involvement in marketing initiatives undertaken by Langford Vets
- To maintain good standing with the RCVS and your specialty board
- To undertake relevant training as requested to expand services offered within Langford Vets
